The Role

• Responsible for the delivery of the IT service model to the London Cluster 3 schools

Key responsibilities

- Management of Senior Technician, Onsite Technicians, Roaming Technicians and apprentices within the local schools' IT Cluster
- Ensure that your team work to Ark SLAs for incidents and service requests. Manage changes, problems, escalations, and major incidents to resolution

- Driven to perfect the end user journey and have responsibility for establishing customer experience mapping and building out the processes that will enable continuous improvement.
- Delegate duties and tasks to members of your team
- Review completed tasks to ascertain compliance with standards
- Have the technical skills to motivate, support and mentor team members.
- Intervene when necessary to aid the group in resolving issues
- Facilitate regular 1:1s with team members, to monitor progress against objectives and development plans
- In collaboration with the Service Delivery Manager set team and individual objectives and create personal development plans
- To maintain: device warranties, asset life cycles, proactive checks of equipment, licences, and documentation
- Have the ability to work under pressure across multiple work streams
- Ensure that your team have the tools and necessary training to carry out their roles with their defined responsibilities.
- Provide guidance, support and training for IT systems as required by the schools
- To ensure 3rd party software and services work in compliance with Ark policies
- Work alongside the Service Delivery Manager to create and issue monthly performance monitoring reports
- To manage the operational relationship with each school within your IT Service Cluster and be the first point of escalation for the schools,
- Ensure regular operational meetings to discuss performance at each of your schools
- Create and foster an environment of IT-supported operational excellence and continuous improvement - establishing and enforcing the highest possible standards for operational service delivery whilst managing and mitigating risk.
