Senior Science Technician

The Role

As Senior Science Technician at Ark Blake Academy, you will be responsible for ensuring that the department is fully resourced and support teachers in delivering high quality practical work, inspiring pupils, and enabling them to develop a deeper understanding of Science. You will also maintain excellent standards of Health and Safety in all areas of the department.

Key Responsibilities

Learning support

- Support teachers when planning and carrying out practical work, highlighting any health and safety causes for concern, following CLEAPSS guidelines
- Prepare and set up practical resources as per department schemes of work
- Prioritise practical requisitions, delivering, setting up and clearing away practicals.
- Provide technical, safety and learning assistance in lessons, supporting students and staff
- Work with Head of Science to allocate work between the members of the department
- Work with the Head of Science to ensure appropriate CPD is delivered or sourced for the Science Technician

General

- Ensure all equipment are properly repaired, maintained, and stored
- Report, replace or arrange repair of apparatus as required
- Ensure the labs and safety equipment are properly maintained
- During term time, manage the care of animals, plants and long term experiments
- Procure biological consumables and other perishable items as necessary
- Maintain a stock list of apparatus and chemicals ensuring that all is appropriately stored and disposed of correctly
- Requisition orders and check goods delivered against those orders

Health & Safety

- Work with the Head of Science to ensure risk assessments related to normal working tasks are carried out, including tasks in the preparation room
- If applicable manage radioactive sources as outlined by CLEAPSS
- Provide First Aid as required (voluntary)

Other

- Actively promote the safety and welfare of our children and young people
- Ensure compliance with data protection rules and procedures
- Support the academy's values and ethos by contributing to the development and implementation of policies, practices and procedures



- Liaise with colleagues and external contacts at all levels of seniority with confidence, tact and diplomacy
- Work with Ark Central and other academies in the Ark network, to establish good practice throughout the network, offering support where required

- Strong IT, administrative and organisational skills
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills with children and adults
- Able to deal with minor incidents including first aid
