- Take on a key role in defining and delivering Ark's data and analytics platform, enabling us to fully leverage the value of the data we hold for our c.28,500 students across 38 schools
- Be pivotal in supporting the organisation to move towards advanced analytical practices
- Work for an organisation that exists to make sure that all children, regardless of their background, have access to a great education and real choices in life

If preferred, the role would be suitable for remote/flexible working, with periodic travel to Ark's central office in West London (c.2 days per week).

About you

We encourage applications from those working within – and outside – the education sector. Applicants should:

- Have 2+ years' experience in a data engineer or similar BI role, and have attained a Graduate degree (or relevant professional experience) in Computer Science, Statistics, Informatics, Information Systems or another quantitative field
- Have awareness of best practice and emerging data systems
- Have advanced working SQL knowledge and experience working with relational databases, query authoring (SQL) as well as working familiarity with a variety of databases (e.g. Postgres)
- Be able to demonstrate a successful history of manipulating, processing and extracting value from large, disconnected datasets
- Be able to quickly understand and become familiar with new data sets – particularly if new to education
- Be aligned with the Ark Schools' vision and values

Key Responsibilities

Data engineering

- Design and build data systems and pipelines with our chosen ETL tooling to Ark business requirements.
- Perform regular and ad-hoc configuration and optimisation of the data platform.
- Manage the deployment and configuration of all databases and servers within Ark Schools which are administered, maintained, and used by the Data & Insight team.
- Act as second line support for systems issues where they relate to the data pipeline.
- Monitor and report on service quality and availability.

Data governance

- Support the creation and maintenance of the data dictionary and business data model.
- Ensure the security and resilience of Ark Schools data platform.
- Ensure appropriate sharing and levels of data access to consumers of Ark data.
- Build and maintain tests of our data to ensure its quality and integrity.
- Work with colleagues with responsibility for/an interest in data governance to ensure the correct handling of Ark data.

Third party connections

- Work with new and transition academies to ensure that data from within our defined ecosystem and other data collection tools is effectively integrated into our data warehouse.
- Manage the interface between the MIS solutions, Ark's data platform and third-party systems.
- Establish and maintain integrations with third party applications.
- Commission third parties who support the Ark data platform to troubleshoot or support system issues.



Project management

- Identify and document any requirements to extend or performance tune the Ark data platform.
- Contract with stakeholders to agree deliverables, resourcing (inc. external spend), and timelines.
- Work with colleagues in the Data and Insight team to understand structural database requirements.
- Participate in the Change Advisory Board to plan and agree changes across Ark data and systems.
- Work with the Lead Data Engineer on the design phase of new in-house projects.
- Undertake small projects as required, to improve current existing processes or to comply with new requirements.

Other

- Perform any other duties or tasks as commensurate with the role to meet the business objectives of Ark Schools.
- Maintain a commitment to professional development and keep abreast of sector and industry developments.
- Attend relevant seminars and learning opportunities to gain knowledge on software matters, new innovations, and trends in data management.
- Support the creation and amendment of dashboards and visualisations in line with project requirements.
- Manage refreshes to ensure that analytics data is surfaced in time and without error.
- Support the management of access to the data consumption tooling


Required


Our data vision
