Ark Soane Academy is a new secondary school in Acton which opened in September 2021 to 180 year 7 students.

We will continue to grow by 180 students each year until reaching full capacity in 2028.

In September 2023 we will move into our new building and welcome our third cohort of students. We are seeking an outstanding Vice Principal who will continue to develop the exceptional culture and academic rigour at Soane as it grows to full capacity.

Ark Soane Academy seeks to redefine what is possible in education: by insisting on the highest standards of behaviour; by delivering an immaculately planned and highly academic curriculum exceptionally well; and by providing our students with a compelling aspirationraising ethos we seek to transform the future of students in a highly deprived community.

Our teachers are supported to uphold the very highest standards of behaviour through centralised systems, and to teach exceptional lessons through shared planning.

The role

We are seeking an outstanding Vice Principal who will drive forward the ambition for an exemplary 11-18 school delivering exceptional academic progress for our community.

You will have significant skills, drive and a proven track record of having had impact in a Secondary setting. You will understand the importance of working hard, creating a high performing team and implementing structures and processes to support all staff and students to be successful. You will work in partnership with a highly ambitious and collaborative Principal and leadership team and alongside a truly exceptional founding cohort of teachers.

The exact responsibilities of this role will depend on the skills of the successful candidate, and we are keen to hear from any strong leaders excited by the challenge of joining our school. You will have the opportunity to lead on critical areas such as culture, behaviour and ethos, curriculum, teaching and learning, inclusion, safeguarding and personal development.

To help you gain experience in all aspects of school leadership the exact role and specific responsibilities of the Vice Principal will be agreed annually and will change regularly.

As Vice Principal you will also be centrally involved in the overall leadership and management of the academy and will help to establish a school culture that is both nurturing and rigorous. You will also have the opportunity to collaborate with colleagues across the network and will feed into the development of excellent practice beyond your own school.

Key Responsibilities:
